## PERSONA - technical rider

To be presented in a white cube gallery/museum space or other unconventional space.

Duration: 30 min

PERSONA set up require an area of minimum 5x3 meter.

Requirements to be provided by the Gallery/Museum/Festival:

- 1 good PA (public address system)
- various black extension cables for regular electric power
- 2 Sound/AV cable to connect PA to a mixing console- mono jack plugs
- 2 microphones (type Shure 58) with cables (5 meter)
- 2 x 1 kw Fresnell w/barndoors or Par 64 CP62 spots (or similar spots)

Set up - Rehearsal - make up - dismantle time:


- 2 hours technical set up time:
- 5 hours of rehearsal with the local extras (preferably the day before the actual performance)
- 2 hours of make up time and sound check
- 1 hour warm up
- 1/2 hour dismantle time

Extras/Statists: 5 male (age 20-60)

The performance require 5 male bi characters that will act as extras. They

can be local students/artists/amateur actors/or just enthusiasts.

The Gallery/Museum/Festival will find these.

Presented in a White Cube Gallery space, PERSONA takes form as a occult ritual, investigating the worshiping of personality in contemporary media Industry through the diffuse concept: stage charisma. A female dancer goes through different emotional and psychological stages revealing a complex relationship to the audience and her 6 male accompanies. PERSONA invites to a contemporary reading of Freuds Narcissism complex through references to early 20th century feminist performance strategies by women artists as Valerie de Saint-Point, Mary Wigman, Vera Fokina and others, and the exploration of the psyche in the 1966 Ingmar Bergman film PERSONA.
